ALBANY – Senator George Borrello issued the following statement today on Governor Hochul signing into law, legislation that will force local governments to move their elections to even-numbered years, placing them alongside elections for Senate, Assembly, statewide offices, Congress and president.

"Just in time for Christmas, Democrats have delivered a lump of coal to New Yorkers in the form of another brazen effort to rig the political system in their favor.

"Although they claim this will benefit local elections by placing them on the ballot in the high-turnout years of federal and state elections, the truth is that local candidates and issues
