

NY State Senate Higher Education Chair Ken LaValle Hosts Higher Ed. Budget Roundtable to Examine Executive Budget Impact on CUNY

New York State Senator Kenneth P. LaValle, Chair of the New York State Senate's Higher Education Committee will chair a first of its kind Higher Education Budget Roundtable with members of the Senate's Higher Education Committee and representatives of the City University of New York (CUNY).

Representatives from CUNY include: Allan H. Dobrin, executive vice chancellor and chief operating officer; Matthew Sapienza, associate vice chancellor for budget and finance and Kathy Abate, budget and finance.

This is the second roundtable LaValle has hosted to examine the Executive Budget and its impact on higher education. LaValle hosted SUNY representatives last week in a comprehensive budget examination session.

"My roundtable establishes a new, creative, open and transparent process to review the Executive Budget, line by line," LaValle said.
