Senate Ends Legislative Session

On Thursday, the 2012 Session of the New York State Legislature came to a close. Highlights of this session include:

- Passage of an on-time New York State Budget for the second straight year, which closed a budget gap without increasing tax, controlling state spending, and creating private-sector jobs.
- Legislation that will protect victims of domestic violence and establish stronger criminal penalties to punish individuals who commit acts of domestic violence.
- The Senate passed legislation that would provide further protections and procedures for students who are bullied or cyberbullied.
