with the esteemed positions of President and State Officers in the Grand Lodge of New York OSIA; and

WHEREAS, In June 1999, Nicholas Viglietta followed in the footsteps of Brother P. Vincent Landi and Brother Angelo Roncallo in receiving the Bene Emeritus Award from the Grand Lodge of New York OSIA for outstanding and distinguished service in the Order; the Bene Emeritus Award is the highest award New York State can bestow on a member; in addition, several of the organization's members have received other state accolades such as Lifetime membership, Dr. Vincenzo Sellaro, and Family of the Year awards; and
