WHEREAS, Since its inception, the Brooklyn Leaders Lions Club has followed the tenets of the Lions Clubs International organization and has strived to create an environment where the spirit is uplifted, and every individual is encouraged to take part in the civic, cultural, social and moral development of their community; members are united through the mutual understanding of the common goal of serving their community; and

WHEREAS, In the last nine years, the Club has been serving its community through back-to-school supplies giveaways, feeding the less fortunate, Christmas toys and Mother's Day baskets giveaways, and eye screenings with the intent of helping if eyeglasses are needed; and

WHEREAS, The Brooklyn Leaders Lions Club also makes donations to some countries in the Caribbean/West Indies, and to the Cancer Society, the TEAL Society, the Blind Society, St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, and many other charitable organizations; and
