WHEREAS, Augustine Paul was also involved in several cultural associations including the India Catholic Association of America, Hudson Valley Malayalee Association, and FOKANA; and

WHEREAS, Known for his kindness, Augustine Paul was dedicated to his family and friends, and was instrumental in his wife Aney becoming a Rockland County Legislator and her endeavors; and
