New York State Sen. Joseph Griffo, R-C-Rome, recently presented a Senate Resolution to Andrew Bailey in recognition of the Chittenango High School senior capturing the 189-pound Division II state wrestling title this past winter.

In front of a capacity crowd and a fan base of family, friends and teammates, Andrew Bailey, the No. 2 seed, earned a 4-3 sudden victory over his No. 5 seed opponent from Wellsville High

School, giving Chittenango High School its second state title in the program's history.

A standout wrestler for the Chittenango Bears, Bailey ended his season with a perfect overall record of 38-0. He was coached by Nic Bacon and Cody Carbery.
