### Senator Serrano Joins New York Public Library Managers to Announce Additional \$150,000 in Library Operating Aid

[Bronx, N.Y., July 31, 2023] — Senator José M. Serrano announced \$150,000 in funding for libraries within the 29th Senate District. The funding was secured during this year's state budget, and will support library programming in three libraries located in the South Bronx and East Harlem. Senator Serrano made the announcement alongside branch managers

from the New York Public Library at the historic Mott Haven Library in the Bronx.
