I commend the Public Service Commission's unanimous decision denying petitions that would increase the renewable energy certificate costs for a number of large-scale renewable energy projects by \$12 billion, a cost that would have been forced onto ratepayers.

Unfortunately, I am disappointed that the Public Service Commission also decided to move forward with a utility rate increase at a time when hard-working New Yorkers are

struggling.

The Senate Republican Conference supports a transition toward a clean energy future but it must be done in a responsible, reliable, and safe manner while maintaining just and reasonable rates through complete transparency and competitive markets.
