State Senator Pam Helming joined members of the Victor-Farmington Ambulance Corps
Board of Directors to commemorate a half-century of service in Ontario County. Throughout
the pandemic and as the surrounding community continues to grow, the ambulance service
has provided unwavering emergency care and transport for 50 years.

Local EMS providers here and across the state have faced a critical shortage of volunteers, and fewer people considering emergency service as a career. Senator Helming has championed initiatives such as the creation of the state's Rural Ambulance Services Task Force and led workgroups leading to the introduction of legislation to support youth training programs. She is exploring the expansion of EMS training and certification programs through BOCES. Read her recent column here.

Senator Helming has also co-sponsored legislation before the Governor that would require insurers to immediately pay ambulance providers directly.

Senator Helming said, "Thank you to Victor-Farmington Ambulance for the incredible care you have provided for our neighbors, family, and friends.
