WHEREAS, His selfless actions did not go unnoticed, and Robert Shuford was rightfully recognized as a local hero by Nassau County Executive Bruce Blakeman; to honor his valor, June 15, 2023, was declared Robert Shuford Day, a testament to his courage and community spirit; and

WHEREAS, Beyond his heroic feat, Robert Shuford is deeply ingrained in the fabric of the Hempstead community; he actively contributes to the welfare of his community through his involvement with the organization, "All the Way 100 percent"; this commitment to community well-being exemplifies Robert's dedication to making Hempstead a better place for all; and
