WHEREAS, This Legislative Body is justly proud to commemorate the 10th Anniversary of the Town of Mineola's Portugal Day Parade; and

WHEREAS, The 10th Annual Portugal Day Parade, in conjunction with the New York Portuguese American Leadership Conference, is hosted on Portugal's National Day and is celebrated on the 9th of June; and

WHEREAS, Portuguese citizens and emigrants throughout the world celebrate Portugal Day and the date commemorates the death of national literary icon, Luis de Camoes, who died on June 10, 1580; and

WHEREAS, The New York Portuguese American Leadership Council, is a nonprofit organization that serves to empower the Portuguese community through advocacy, education, and networking; they aim to preserve and promote Portuguese culture and heritage, while also promoting economic and social development within the community; and
