(ELCA) since 1990, serving as President, Vice President, and Secretary of the synodical organization; and

WHEREAS, She currently serves as the Co-coordinator of the Hudson Mohawk Conference and the Editor of the women's newsletter, Evangel-Lines, and has helped coordinate a joint Spring and Fall gathering with the Hudson Mohawk and Foothills conferences for the last two years; and

National Guard from May of 1980 to August of 1987; and
