(ALBANY, NY) - State Senator Shelley B. Mayer announced today that Majority Leader Andrea Stewart-Cousins has reappointed her to Chair the Senate Committee on Education and has newly appointed her to Chair the Senate Committee on Ethics and Internal Governance.

Senator Mayer was first appointed to Chair the Senate Education Committee in 2019 and has served in this role since then. Mayer also takes leadership of the Senate's Ethics and Internal Governance Committee, following the retirement of the former Chair, Senator Neil Breslin. Senator Mayer also has been appointed Co-Chair of the New York State Legislative Ethics Commission. The Commission is responsible for administering and enforcing the provisions of Public Officers Law §§ 73, 73-a and 74 for members of the legislative bodies, employees of the legislature, and candidates for state legislative office.

Senator Mayer has been newly appointed to serve as a standing member on the Senate Committee on Finance and will continue to serve as a standing member on the Senate Committees on Elections, Judiciary, Labor, and Rules.

Senator Shelley Mayer said, "I am proud to once again have the honor of chairing the Senate's Education Committee. I will continue to fight for students and schools across New York and to fulfill the state's commitment to ensuring that every child, regardless of their zip code or need, receives a high-quality education.
