WHEREAS, It is crucial that individuals with developmental disabili-

ties have access to the resources that allow them to live secure, fulfilling lives, including education, housing, employment, and recreational activities; and

WHEREAS, Opportunities for citizens with developmental disabilities to live as independently and productively as possible must be fostered throughout New York; now, therefore, be it
