Thomas, Donald, Mary McArdle, and Charles; today, he is the loving grandfather of 10 grandchildren and five great-grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, A dedicated and involved member of his community, Mike Chemotti was very involved with the Westvale Solvay Steelers Pop Warner Football League; he remains an active member of the Solvay Geddes Veterans and the Tyrol Club, where he enjoys playing cards and having lunch with friends; and

WHEREAS, This exceptional centenarian, with his zest for life, has inspired and enhanced the lives of his family and friends, and experienced the incredible joys and sorrows characteristic of and reserved for those with the stamina and courage to savor a full life; now, therefore, be it
