WHEREAS, During his career, James Buff was Lieutenant and Captain of the Coon Hill Company, District 2, Assistant Fire Chief for 10 consecutive years, Finance Secretary for 14 consecutive years, Chairman of the Board of Trustees, Chairman of the 175th Celebration, Chairman of the Firehouse Sponsorship Committee, Chairman of the Labor Day Celebration, President of the Skaneateles Volunteer Fire Department, and the announcer for the Labor Day Parade; and also emceed the Skaneateles Fire Department's Installation Dinner for more than 45 years; and WHEREAS, Throughout the long history of the Skaneateles Fire Depart-

ment, one thing has remained constant, the dedication, hard-work, commitment and sacrifices of men and women like James Buff; and WHEREAS, James Buff has volunteered his time year in and year out, working long hours and sacrificing time with his family to protect the lives and properties of his neighbors and fellow residents of Skaneateles; and

WHEREAS, After 50 years, James Buff still continues to serve the residents of Skaneateles and surrounding communities as an active fireman; now, therefore, be it
