WHEREAS, Adam Tyler Day's perseverance in rising through the ranks to Eagle Scout is a strong indication of his ability to master difficult tasks; his accomplishment will enable him to emerge as a leader, fully equipped to meet the challenges of today's complex society; and

WHEREAS, Adam Tyler Day graduated from Ichabod Crane High School, Kinderhook, New York, where he was president of his senior class, participated on the golf team, and was captain of the wrestling team; he is presently attending Hudson Valley Community College with a focus on engineering science; and

WHEREAS, He is a member of St. John the Baptist Church, and volunteers for the Marion Stegmann food drive, as well as with Pee wee wrestling; an avid outdoorsman, he is also a member of the Glencadia Rod and Gun Club; and
