of guiding and inspiring her team members towards their goals; and WHEREAS, She graduated from Wilkes University with a bachelor's degree in psychology, and went on to obtain a master's in community and counseling psychology; and

WHEREAS, With her throughout have been her husband, Dave, and their triplets, Hudson, Harper, and Sadie, all of whom feel privileged to be a part of her life and rejoice in her achievements; and

WHEREAS, Athletes such as Rena Gorish Marr provide a tremendous service to the future of our State and Nation, inspiring generations of student-athletes in their athletic journeys and ensuring their success in their future years; and
