where she performed the works of Samuel Barber and James Legg, Cole Porter, Irving Berlin and Ray Henderson; and

WHEREAS, Rare indeed is the impressive dedication shown by an individual for the benefit of others which Stephanie Blythe has displayed throughout her life; and

WHEREAS, It is the practice of this Legislative Body that those who enhance the well-being and vitality of their community and have shown a long and sustained commitment to excellence certainly have earned the recognition and applause of all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
