WHEREAS, America has achieved her greatest heights of glory through the dedication, determination and tireless efforts of the outstanding citizens of this Nation; and

WHEREAS, It is only with the continued diligence and devotion of our youth, tomorrow's leaders, that America will maintain her glory; and

ing garden for the North Chatham Free Library; this industrious Scout raised funds and supervised work crews to build a 50-foot long stone wall, remove an overgrown garden bed, and create a new planting bed with shade perennials behind the wall; in addition, he restored four benches for a new seating area; and

WHEREAS, Matthew Scott Caluneo's perseverance in rising through the ranks to Eagle Scout is a strong indication of his ability to master difficult tasks; his accomplishment will enable him to emerge as a leader, fully equipped to meet the challenges of today's complex society; and
