ities supported by the Syracuse Teacher Center; these activities include courses, workshops, mentoring, training sessions, the creation of class-

room materials and instructional equipment, and a variety of other activities; and

WHEREAS, During his tenure on the Syracuse Teacher Center Policy Board, John Ciero has provided support to countless teachers and rendered faithful, conscientious and valuable service to the Syracuse City School District; he has held the position of board chairman since 2009, making him the longest serving member in Syracuse; he was also a part of the negotiations team with the Syracuse Teachers Association; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that those who enhance the quality of life in their communities, demonstrating a long and sustained commitment to the maintenance of high standards in the field of education, have earned the esteem and respect of their colleagues and recognition from all citizens of the State of New York; now, therefore, be it
