WHEREAS, With a sense of civic responsibility, Luz Maria Negron contributes her time helping children at the Club, while also preparing and serving meals at a local food pantry in the Bronx; in addition, she educates fellow students on the prevention of HIV/AIDS and other sexually transmitted diseases; and

WHEREAS, Respected in her community for her volunteer service, Luz Maria Negron is also an excellent student who participates in many extracurricular activities; she is the captain of both her swimming and softball teams, and is a lifeguard at the Madison Square Boys & Girls Club in the Bronx; and

WHEREAS, Luz Maria Negron plans to attend college and pursue her Ph.D. in Forensic Science in order to detect evidence in support of those who have been victims of crimes; and

WHEREAS, Displaying a strong sense of duty and a commitment to others, Luz Maria Negron represents the best development of the potential which is inherent in our most precious resource, our youth; now, therefore, be it
