WHEREAS, Under the luminous direction of Monsignor William Breslawski, the Ministries and programs of Our Lady of Peace have grown in number and strength, thus providing the support he needed to run and pastor the people of this parish community; he prepares to leave the parish and move to Rocky Point where he will assume the pastor's position of St. Anthony of Padua; and
