WHEREAS, The athletic talent displayed by this team is due in great part to the efforts of Head Coach Bob Underwood, a skilled and inspirational mentor, respected for his ability to develop potential into

excellence; and

WHEREAS, The team's overall record was outstanding; and the team members were loyally and enthusiastically supported by family, fans, friends and the community at large; and

WHEREAS, The hallmarks of the Queensbury High School Girls Cross Country Team from the opening meet of the season to capturing the championship, were a sisterhood of athletic ability, of good sportsmanship, of honor and of scholarship, demonstrating that these team players are second to none; and
