Ferrara was assigned to the position of Acting Police Chief on numerous occasions during the absence of two past Police Chiefs, as well as from September through December 2004, after the retirement of Chief Bloom; and WHEREAS, While performing his duties as a Patrolman, Michael D. Ferrara completed numerous assignments, including: Accident-Reconstruction/Investigation Unit, SCUBA Team, SWAT Team, Motorcycle Unit, Crime Scene Unit, Detective Division, Internal Affairs Unit, and as a Certified Police Instructor; and WHEREAS, Throughout his illustrious career, Police Chief Michael D. Ferrara received more than 70 Certificates including: Executive Development, Group Assertiveness Skills for Managers, Community Policing, Instructor Development, Executive Leadership, Managerial Communications, Value Centered Leadership, Customer Service, Project Management, Human Resources, and Strategic Planning; and WHEREAS, In an impressive career spanning more than four decades, Police Chief Michael D.
