WHEREAS, Active in her community, Marie Moloney volunteered her time and energies every year for the Board of Elections; in addition, for 25 years, she worked as a home-care aide, assisting homebound seniors all around both Bay Ridge, and Staten Island; and

WHEREAS, Today, Marie Moloney lives in Breezy Point, Queens, and walks to church every day and participates in many activities throughout the year with her friends and family; and
