WHEREAS, In 1985, Mick Dorgan re-located to New York City and found work at various construction sites; four years later, he changed careers and started bartending at the Glenore Bar in Bay Ridge, New York; and

WHEREAS, Mick Dorgan, along with two partners, opened their own bar, The Wicked Monk in 1994, which he still owns today; throughout the years, he held many fundraisers for various NYC and local Bay Ridge organizations; and

WHEREAS, In 2000, Mick Dorgan joined the FDNY and was assigned to Spanish Harlem; 10 years later, he retired due to a job related injury; and

WHEREAS, Mick Dorgan is a vital member of several Irish organizations, the FDNY Emerald Society, Ancient Order of Hibernians (AOH), and the Brooklyn Shamrocks; he also helps coach his sons on their respective sports teams; and

WHEREAS, With him throughout have been his wife, Celeste, and his children, Mike and Shane, all of whom feel privileged to be a part of his life and rejoice in his achievements; and

WHEREAS, A fitting choice for Deputy Marshal of the 22nd Annual Bay Ridge St. Patrick's Day Parade, Mick Dorgan embodies the spirit and the cherished ideals and values of Irish-Americans of this great State and Nation; now, therefore, be it
