WHEREAS, Carl Bloomberg was the former Campaign Chair for the annual fundraising drive of the Jewish Federation of Northeastern New York, and a past member of its Endowment Committee; in addition, he served on the Board of Daughters of Sarah, and was a volunteer at Senior Services in Albany; and

WHEREAS, In 2010, Carl Bloomberg was the recipient of the distinguished Dr. Morton Berger Memorial Award by the Maimonides Hebrew Day School; and

WHEREAS, The Sidney Albert Albany Jewish Community Center provides a nurturing environment where individuals and families can grow and develop in mind, body, and spirit; and

WHEREAS, This vital organization's core values are rooted in Jewish principles, representing the interest, concerns, and perspectives of the Jewish community, and the community at large, and welcomes all members regardless of their faith or background; and

WHEREAS, Rare indeed is the impressive dedication shown by individuals for the benefit of others which Carl Bloomberg has displayed throughout his life; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that those who enhance the well-being and vitality of their community and have shown a long and sustained commitment to excellence certainly have earned the

recognition and applause of all the citizens of this great Empire State;
