WHEREAS, Loretta Nwanyibunya Smith also opened the Hotel Bon Voyage in Nigeria, which has also received many honors; and

WHEREAS, Active in her community, Loretta Nwanyibunya Smith has helped many people in numerous ways, including feeding and clothing less fortunate elderly citizens and children who reside in orphanage homes, counseling wrongly detained Nigerian prisoners, creating jobs for unemployed youths and adults, giving marital advice, and housing the homeless; and
