WHEREAS, Cadet First Lieutenant Neal M. Bailey joined the Civil Air Patrol in 2010; and

WHEREAS, This esteemed young man has met the rigorous requirements in leadership, physical fitness, character, Aerospace Education, an exam, and an encampment; and
