WHEREAS, Renowned and well-respected in his field, Jason Brzoska has been the recipient of numerous awards and accolades, including his selection to the Professional Leaders Project in 2004, and a Jewish scholarship to the Gestalt International Study Center's "Leadership in the 21st Century," a prestigious executive training program; and
