the "impresarios" of Syracuse, New York, by not only giving performances

themselves, but sponsoring performances by others; and WHEREAS, From 1894 until 1980, Civic Morning Musicals, Inc. brought famous orchestras, instrumental groups, and soloists from all over the globe to perform in Syracuse; and

WHEREAS, Since 1980 to the present, Civic Morning Musicals, Inc. has provided performance opportunities to the most accomplished artists in Central New York; and

WHEREAS, Over the past 35 years, Civic Morning Musicals, Inc. have facilitated many programs and performances to the community, including a Sunday Concert Series, vocal competition, and weekly recitals; and WHEREAS, Civic Morning Musicals, Inc. have also engaged the youth of the Central New York community via creation of a Junior Performing Arts program designed to hone the skills of those learning the performing

arts, and an awards program for high school, and college artists; and WHEREAS, It is the custom of this Legislative Body to make note of enduring community performing arts organizations and to bring such institutions to the attention of the people of this Empire State; now, therefore, be it
