SENATE RESOLUTION establishing a plan setting forth an itemized list of grantees for certain appropriations for the 2015-2016 state fiscal year, as required by subdivision 5 of section 24 of the state finance law

RESOLVED, That pursuant to and as required by subdivision 5 of section 24 of the state finance law, moneys appropriated in section 1 of chapter 53 of the laws of 2015 which enacts the Aid To Localities budget under the Administration Program for the Department of Environmental Conservation from the Local Assistance Account, for the Catskill Master Plan Stewardship and Planning shall be apportioned pursuant to subdivision 5 of section 24 of the state finance law, in accordance with the following schedule:

Catskill Watershed Corporation for Catskill Master Plan Stewardship and Planning 500,000

RESOLVED, That pursuant to and as required by subdivision 5 of section 24 of the state finance law, moneys appropriated in section 1 of chapter 54 of the laws of 2015 which enacts the Capital Projects budget under the Environment and Recreation (CCP) for the Department of Environmental Conservation from the Environmental Protection Fund/Environment and Recreation Purpose, for local waterfront revitalization programs shall be apportioned pursuant to subdivision 5 of section 24 of the state finance law, in accordance with the following schedule:

RESOLVED, That pursuant to and as required by moneys appropriated in subdivision 5 of section 24 of the state finance law, moneys appropriated in section 1 of chapter 53 of the laws of 2015 which enacts the Aid to Localities budget, local assistance account, for services and expenses of invasive species and dredging projects. Such funds shall be apportioned pursuant to a plan setting forth an itemized list of grantees with the amount to be received by each, or the methodology for allocating such appropriation. Such plan shall be subject to the approval of the temporary president of the senate and the director of the budget and thereafter shall be included in a resolution calling for the expenditure of such monies, which resolution must be approved by a majority vote of all members elected to the senate upon a roll call vote, in accordance with the following schedule:

RESOLVED, That pursuant to and as required by subdivision 5 of section 24 of the state finance law, moneys appropriated in section 1 of chapter 53 of the laws of 2014 which enacts the Aid to Localities budget, Local Assistance account, for services and expenses of invasive species and dredging projects shall be apportioned pursuant to subdivision 5 of section 24 of the state finance law, in accordance with the following schedule:

Oswego Soil and Water Conservation District for Oswego River invasive control projects 150,000
