As in previous years, visitors will also be able to access health services such as no-out-of-pocket-cost flu vaccinations provided by the Nassau Health Care Corporation (subject to availability), free blood pressure screenings, free chiropractic screenings, and free hearing screenings.

The Town of Hempstead Town Clerk's office will also be offering on site passport services to all in attendance. Seniors who want to obtain or renew a passport should call Senator Fuschillo's office for more information about requirements.

The event also includes musical entertainment and refreshments will be served.

In cooperation with the Towns of Hempstead, Oyster Bay and Babylon, as well as the Village of Massapequa Park, free transportation will be available from ten locations for seniors.

"The Golden Gathering allows senior citizens to access a wide variety of information and get several different types of free health care screenings all under one roof," Senator Fuschillo said. "I hope that all seniors will take advantage of this special event by visiting the Freeport Recreation Center on October 22nd."
