Appointments will be available at his district office located at 7408-5th Avenue, from February 4th through April 15th, every Thursday from 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. and on Saturdays, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

Senator Golden stated "Filing tax returns can be a complicated and arduous process. My office will assist local residents with their filings to ensure that everything is done properly. Tax season can be a stressful time, but the service we provide will hopefully make life a little easier for my constituents. I encourage those interested to call and schedule an appointment as this program continues to be very popular as appointments are limited."
