Henry Frank; Ebbets Field Community Development Center and its Director Michelle Adolphe; and Haitian American National Alliance and its Executive Director Dr. George Casimir. Working in partnership with these organizations, we will coordinate with Chase Bank and establish an account dedicated to all money raised for those affected by the calamity.
