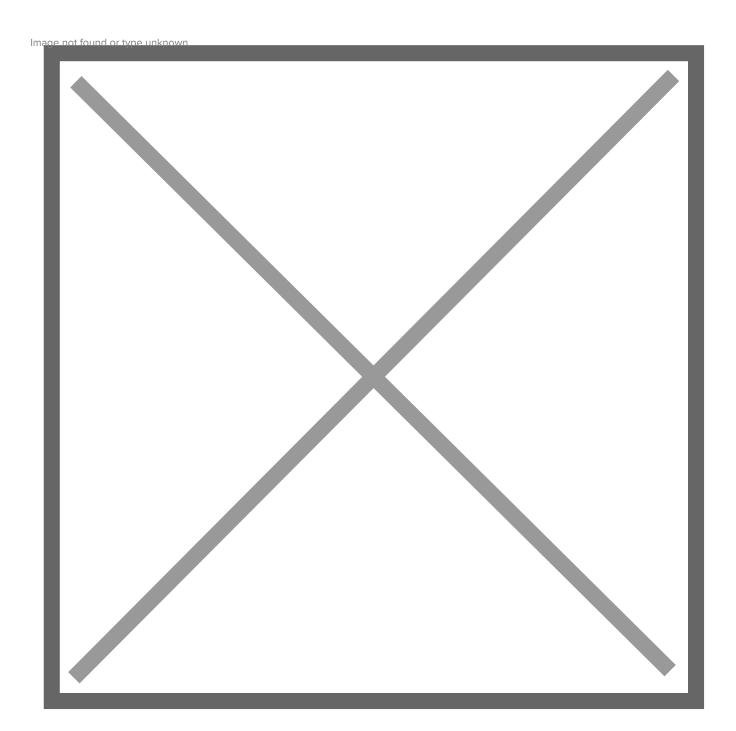


## Support the Allegany and Long Point State Parks

Our parks draw more than a million visitors to our region every year. They provide an inexpensive


recreational resource to families on tight budgets.
