

Senator Steve Saland to Hold Senior Seminar

The seminar will feature elder law attorneys who will discuss a number of important issues facing seniors such as estate planning, wills and trusts, end-of-life decisions, nursing home care, etc.

The seminar will also feature a representative from The Alzheimer's Association who will discuss understanding memory loss and what services are available for persons diagnosed with Alzheimer's Disease and their caregivers.

A question and answer period will follow each presentation.
