## Residents Invited to Safely Dispose of Their Medications at Village's Earth Day Celebration

Senator Charles J. Fuschillo, Jr. (R-Merrick) is partnering with the Village of Massapequa Park and the Nassau County Police Department to help residents safely dispose of their expired or unused medications.

The "Shed the Meds" program will be part of the Village's annual Earth Day Celebration in Brady Park, located on Lake Shore Drive between Front Street and Clark Boulevard, between 9 am and 1 pm on Saturday April 24th. Residents can drop off any medication that has expired or they no longer need, where it will be collected and safely disposed of by officers from the Nassau County Police Department.

Throwing out medication improperly, such as flushing them in the toilet or pouring them down the drain, can cause them to pollute local waterways. Safe disposal helps protect the environment and keeps

medications out of the hands of young children or others who would use them improperly.
