Buffalo, NY – There is a water quality problem with Scajaquada Creek and New York State Senator Antoine Thompson (D-parts of Erie & Niagara Counties) is holding a Summit to find ways to clean it up. Thompson will assemble community stakeholders to discuss concerns and the best approach to improving the creek's water quality.
