"I commend you for your bravery," said Senator Parker, as he talked to the men. Senator Parker then spent time discussing the men's recovery with the doctors and nurses on site. Senator Parker has a maintained a strong relationship with the Boro Park community of which he services under the purview of his Senate office. During the last eight years he has allocated approximately \$15 million in funding to the 21st District, \$1 million of which has gone to supporting community-based Jewish organizations like the Shomrim.
