Senator Golden sent multiple letters to MTA Chairman Jay Walder with suggestions for alternate service. Senator Golden forwarded numerous emails to the MTA's Government Affairs office detailing the problems with our bus service cuts. Senator Golden spoke before MTA board hearings detailing the devastating effects these cuts would have. He hosted a town hall meeting with executives of the MTA so they could hear directly from riders.
