This new location will adequately serve each student by providing them with a healthy learning environment and abundant resources.

The new buildings have put the department of Education on track to add nearly 100,000 new school seats across the city by 2013, reducing overcrowding in schools and ensuring that students have the opportunity to learn in modern facilities.
