"Sexism, discrimination, homophobia, and racism are prevalent in our society and diminish our progress as a nation. I encourage all New Yorkers to reflect on our history and accomplishments this month and rededicate ourselves to fairness and equality for all, and volunteer in a way that helps women in our

community," concluded Senator Smith.
