Residents Invited to Help by Donating Non-Perishable Food & Other Items

All food collected through the program will be donated to Long Island Cares, which delivers food to over 500 food pantries, soup kitchens, shelters, and other assistance organizations. The food drive will run through the end of April.

This food drive will help provide a helping hand to those families who have fallen on hard times. I thank Long Island Cares for partnering with me in this program and invite all residents to participate," said Senator Fuschillo.

- * household items
- * baby care items
- * school supplies
