Hundreds of local residents visited the Freeport Recreation Center to receive information about job training, career counseling, and other employment advice through a Job Resource Expo sponsored by Senator Charles J. Fuschillo, Jr. (R-Merrick).

"I'm extremely pleased that so many people were able to take advantage of these services. At a time when over 116,000 Long Islanders are unemployed and competition for jobs is extremely high, there is a significant need for services that better prepare individuals to find a job or a new career. This event helped residents learn the tools to land the job they want," said Senator Fuschillo.

Representatives from 22 different government agencies, nonprofit organizations, and colleges provided a host of different services to those in attendance. Residents were able to have their resumes

reviewed, get information about job training programs, and learn job searching tips & interviewing skills. Information was also provided about upcoming civil service exams, continuing education, social service assistance programs, and starting a small business.
