

Senator Fuschillo Announces Appointment of Merrick Resident to Statewide Anti-Smoking Advisory Board

Prior to that, she served as Executive Director for the Community Wellness Council of the Bellmores and Merricks, a non-profit organization whose mission is to promote substance abuse prevention by fostering emotional and physical wellness. She is also a Past-President of the Child Care Council of Nassau County.

As a member of the board, Ms. Volk will be advising the State's Health Commissioner on ways to prevent and reduce tobacco use in New York State.
