"Star Spangled Banner" by American Idol contestant, and Merrick resident, Robbie Rosen. Congressman Peter King (R-Seaford) served as the event's guest speaker.

Veterans were then treated to breakfast, followed by a short video tribute thanking them for their service to our country.

Senator Fuschillo also gave special recognition to two special veterans, Merrick resident Robert Tom Riordan and Roosevelt resident George A. Jones, for their decades of service to our country, their fellow veterans, and their communities. Both men were selected by Senator Fuschillo as members of the New York State Senate's Veterans Hall of Fame.
