Aluminum Company To Add 100 New Jobs

State Senator Patty Ritchie praised Novelis for the company's decision to invest \$200 million in its Oswego County operations to expand the company's aluminum sheet production for the automotive industry which is expected to add 100 new jobs in Central New York.

"I want to thank Novelis for believing in the future of Oswego County and New York State," Senator Ritchie said. "Last month, I sponsored my Career Expo that featured Novelis and other companies. Novelis expects to hire approximately 100 new employees in Oswego County over the next two years leading to start-up of the new equipment in the summer of 2013.
